AUCKLAND COUNCIL FOOD SAFETY BYLAW 2013
Basic Food Hygiene Certificate Course, Food Safety Online.

Further to our telephone conversation this morning and my on-going perusal of the training materials provided, it is confirmed that the basic food hygiene certificate course meets the definition of **Approved basic food hygiene course** in our bylaw.

Approved basic food hygiene course means a training program which has been accredited by the New Zealand Qualifications Authority for the purposes of food preparation and handling training, or an alternative course in food hygiene approved in writing by an environmental health officer.

Our bylaw also states in 7(1) A person will not be issued with a certificate of registration after 30 June 2013 for any food premises unless:

- (a) the person has passed an approved basic food hygiene course and will normally be present at the food premises when food is manufactured, prepared, handled or sold; or
- (b) there will be working full-time on the premises a manager or staff member with specific responsibility for staff training and supervision who has passed an approved basic food hygiene course and is involved in food manufacture, preparation and handling at that specific premises.

I would advise you to read 7(2), (3), (4), (5) and (6) for a full understanding of the training requirements for the various legacy councils.
